Welcome back! I hope you had a good break over the summer holiday and had time to relax as a family and to enjoy the glorious weather. We have enjoyed welcoming our young people back to school and hearing their news. The new Year 7 have acquitted themselves very well, looking smart and ready to enjoy all that Challoner has to offer.

September has brought a number of welcome new faces to the community: Ms Boyd in SEN, Miss Chong in History, Mr Hackston in Science, Mrs Mills in SEN, Miss Reilly in English, Mr Toprani in Maths and Mrs Wood as Matron on Mondays and Tuesdays. Between them, they bring many years of experience and passion for education and I am sure will all make a very positive impact on the school.

GCSE Results

The whole community of Bishop Challoner is delighted with the fantastic results of our students this summer. This represents a strong performance across the subjects in this first year of more demanding syllabuses and assessments. 80% of students achieved five 9-4 grades including English and Mathematics. Over 80% achieved passes in at least two sciences. Well over half of the cohort achieved the challenging EBacc measure across a wide range of subjects.

As always, a number of students performed exceptionally well in spite of extreme and adverse circumstances and their courage and commitment is an inspiration to their peers and the school community. We are proud of the achievements of all our students; of particular note: Ciaron achieved a perfect set of 9s. Jennie achieved an A in AS Maths, seven 9s, two 8s and a 7. Emily received an A in AS Maths with ten GCSEs at grade 9 or 8. Bethan also got an A in AS Maths with ten GCSEs including six 9s.

These excellent outcomes are testament to the students' hard work, determination and self-belief and are just rewards for all their efforts and hours dedicated to studying. Credit, of course, is due too, to the relentless pursuit of excellence and high standards shown by all staff who take great joy in sharing in the students' superb achievements. The school could not have achieved such high outcomes without the unfailing support of our parents, carers and governors whose loyalty and service provides the foundation for all that is achieved at Bishop Challoner Catholic School. We are grateful as always for the prayers of our local parish communities.

The school wishes all of our Year 11 Leavers the very best of luck as they pursue their chosen courses and careers in and around the local colleges.
