Learners in this category will face barriers to learning in the following areas:

- Poor auditory memory and sequencing skills
- Slow processing speeds
- •Weak literacy and numeracy skills, low reading age
- •Some will have specific learning difficulties such as dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia
- •Poor transference of info from short term to long term memory

Communication & Interaction C&I

Learners in this category will face barriers to learning in the following areas:

- Poor auditory memory and sequencing skills
- •Slow processing speeds due to poor receptive and expressive language skills, may have issues with literality
- •Are in a persistent state of high anxiety, with irrational fears and habitual behaviour
- •Poor emotional literacy, with weak social and collaborative skills
- •May have a speech impediment/ stammer
- •Inattentiveness, hyperactivity, impulsivity
- Attachment Disorders
- ASC tendencies (Autistic Spectrum Conditions)
 - ADHD / PDA / ODD/ Asperger's
 - OCD/ Selective Mutism

Social, Emotional and Mental Health SEMH

Learners in this category will face barriers to learning in the following areas:

- •Low self esteem, negative self image, lack of confidence, social anxiety disorders
- •Poor state of well-being as a result of a variety of issuesdepression, eating disorders, self-harm, **CP** issues.
- •Gaps in learning due to school absences
- •Isolation selective mutism, school phobia
- •Aggression negative attention seeking behaviours, anger management issues
- •Anti-social behaviours with underlying causes.

Sensory and Physical Disability S&PD

Learners in this category will face barriers to learning in the following areas:

- •Hearing Impaired -HI
- Visually Impaired- VI
- •Other Physical disabilities **CP,** Genetic disorders, Neuropathic loss of feeling, Epilepsy
- •Gaps in learning due to school absences
- •Lack of focus due to pain, fatigue etc.
- •Emotional issues linked to disability- confidence, self esteem/image, frustration
- •External barriers Equal access to the curriculum, equal access to rooms, equipment etc.
