Revision of core content and embedding of exam technique. Re-addressing of key misconceptions and the supporting of independent study.

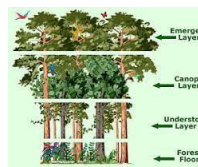
**The Changing Economic World**

**Urban Issues and Challenges**  
A study of how a growing percentage of the world's population lives in cities and the opportunities and challenges this causes both in the UK and globally.



**River Landscapes**  
A study of how rivers are shaped by processes and the landforms they create. We will also explore the management techniques used on our water ways.



**The Living world**  
An overview to ecosystems including the UK, tropical rainforests and hot deserts. We discover the uses and management of these natural environments.

**The Challenge of Natural Hazards**  
An overview of natural hazards (tectonic and weather) focusing on the causes, impacts, responses and management of a range of case studies.

**Fairtrade and Climate Change**  
Exploring what Fairtrade is and how communities can adapt to climate change.

**Development**  
Exploring what helps and hinders a country's development. Discovering how globalisation is impacting people.

**Fieldwork Enquiry 1**  
Developing the ability to carry out both primary and secondary data collection to apply to a geographical enquiry.



## Coastal Landscapes

A study of how the coast is shaped by processes and the landforms they create. We will also look at the management we put in place to protect it.



**Rivers**  
Exploring physical processes that create our river landforms

**Glaciers**  
Exploring the physical processes that create our glacial landforms. Discovering how climate has impacted glacial landscapes.



**Population and Migration**  
Exploring how population is distributed across our planet and developing our knowledge of why people migrate

## Urbanisation and Economic Activity

Exploring the characteristics, as well as the patterns and distributions of urban growth.

**Weather and Climate**  
Exploring the factors that influence both the weather and climate. Discovering the impacts of major weather events.



**Flooding**  
Exploring the causes and impacts of flooding using LIC and HIC case studies.



**Tectonic Activity**  
Exploring the physical processes that cause volcanoes and earthquakes. Discovering the impact that tectonic hazards have on people.



**Africa**  
Exploring the continent of Africa and the countries that make it what it is.



**Wonderful World**  
Exploring the seven continents whilst building upon the geographical skills to set students up on their learning journey.
