# <u>Attendance</u>

- A student who is absent a day a week misses an equivalent of two years of their school life
- 90% of young people with absence rates below 85% fail to achieve 5 or more good grades at GCSE
- Absence can lead to significant gaps in learning which will effect wellbeing, confidence and overall performance across the five year journey



#### **Punctuality**


If in a school year your child is late everyday	Your child would have lost approximately	Or they would have missed approximately

### Guide to Grades

A student's end of year target grade is based on KS2 SAT data and other contextual information. The projected target (1-9) is based on the progress made by students in the top 20% of schools across the country, taken from Fischer Family Trust data.

- ✓ Three data collection points per academic year
- ✓ One written report and one academic Parent's Evening per academic year



#### Assessment and feedback

Feedback informs future work to help pupils reflect upon their learning and to improve. This will be written as **targets (T)** with **PURPLE PEN**:

- ✓ Relate to planned learning objectives.
- ✓ Recognise pupils' achievements.
- ✓ Indicate the next steps in pupils' learning.

Students are expected to respond with **GREEN PEN**, correcting errors and improving their work.

The use of **Learning Ladders** are present in termly assessments and end of unit pieces of work. They show the areas that need to be targeted to progress and are designed to enable students to develop skills that will correlate to GCSE assessments.
