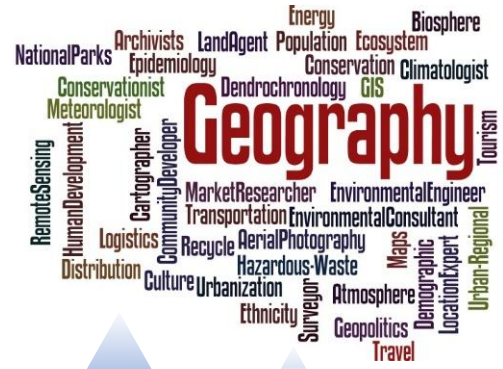

Revision of core content and embedding of exam technique. Re-addressing of key misconceptions and the supporting of independent study.



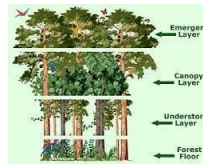
The Changing Economic World
A study of how LICs and NEEs are experiencing rapid economic developments and how major changes in the UK economy will impact us.



Urban Issues and Challenges
A study of how a growing percentage of the world's population lives in cities and the opportunities and challenges this causes both in the UK and globally.



River Landscapes
A study of how rivers are shaped by processes and the landforms they create. We will also explore the management techniques used on our water ways.



The Living world
An overview to ecosystems including the UK, tropical rainforests and hot deserts. We discover the uses and management of these natural environments.



Coastal Landscapes
A study of how the coast is shaped by processes and the landforms they create. We will also look at the management we put in place to protect it.



The Challenge of Natural Hazards
An overview of natural hazards (tectonic and weather) focusing on the causes, impacts, response and management of a range of case studies.

Tectonic Activity

Exploring the physical processes that cause volcanoes and earthquakes. Including a study of super volcanoes.

Fieldwork Enquiries
Developing the ability to carry out both primary and secondary data collection to apply to a geographical enquiry.



Oceania
Exploring climate change and weather with a focus on Oceania

Glaciers
Exploring the physical processes that create our glacial landforms. Discovering how climate has impacted glacial landscapes.



Tsunamis
Exploring the physical that cause a tsunami and comparing the effects of two examples

Rivers
Exploring physical processes that create our river landforms



Russia
Exploring Russia's climate zones and soils



Fairtrade
Exploring what Fairtrade is and the impacts it has.



Asia
Exploring development and population within Asia



Africa
Exploring the natural resources and rock types across Africa with a focus on the Rift Valley.

Population and Migration
Exploring how population is distributed with a focus on the Middle East



South America
Exploring the climates and biomes of South America

Plastic Pollution
Exploring what plastic pollution is and where it is occurring

Antarctica
Exploring geological skills through Antarctica.



North America
Exploring economic activity and globalisation within North America with a focus on Coca-Cola.

Europe
Exploring urbanisation and migration with a focus on Europe
